





ID systems strengthen social development and public governance goals like equal rights to economic resources including property and finance specifically for women, rationalization of the subsidies through targeted individual transfers in the energy sector, safe and responsible migration, fighting crime and terrorism and improvements in maternal and child health. Therefore, prioritizing the deployment of the ID system can often be advised as a strong precursor to the national agenda for the other SDGs. Successful global models of the role of an ID system in public governance strengthening and SDG compliance; could prove to be a strong incentive for many countries with nascent ID systems . in place.



The scores are directly proportional to the government effectiveness







Success Story - INDIA AADHAAR





Savings by Aadhaar-\$8572.25 Mn*

Aadhaar costs less than \$1.3 per person






Data is encrypted*

A 12-digit unique identity number that can be utilized by the resident, as a proof of identity and for availing various benefits and subsidies, through various government sponsored and other schemes



AEPS (Aadhaar Enabled Payment System) extends services to the unbanked pockets

APB (Aadhaar Payment Bridge) uses Aadhaar credentials to transfer welfare benefits

Benefits are transferred from government agencies to individuals via Aadhaar linked bank accounts

Micro ATMs provide basic banking services to people through a simple machine

The machine authenticates digital transactions via the Aadhaar identity system



Enrolment has hit a saturation of 99%

30k+ Enrolment centers





16963.8 Mn authentications performed*

30-60 Mn authentications performed per day*






